2018 Report from Executive Director, Fred Bauermeister

The history of the Free Clinic has been full of ups and downs, I suppose like life in general. With the collapse of the Under One Roof (UOR) project, 2018 was focused on recovery, resolve and resolution.

The Board of Directors of the Free Clinic needs to be commended and appreciated

for their dedication to the creation of the new Multi Services Center (MSC). This Board has persevered, even while having experienced personal financial loss for their individual investments in the UOR project, plus dealing with the fallout from the loss of funds entrusted to the Free Clinic by valued donors.

They rallied their friends and families, asking them to stand with them as the Clinic launched this new project. They did this freely without personal benefit, but for the common belief that the project will benefit the whole community. Their effort helped us recover from what could have been an agency ending disaster.

The Board committed to a capital campaign to raise the \$1.5M needed to buildout the MSC (the County of Ventura is leasing the building to the Clinic for \$1 per year) to accommodate the Free Clinic and several other nonprofit organizations. Based on that commitment, Kaiser Permanente National Facilities Services (NFC) brought in architects and planners to assist with the layout of the floor plan for the new MSC. The connection with Kaiser led us to the architectural firm Perkins+Will, which is donating their services as the architects of record for the project.

While the Board remained focused on the capital campaign, the volunteers of the Free Clinic continued to provide basic health and social services to members of the community in need. Kaiser Permanente and Adventist Health brought their significant support together to provide medical services for 2,818 patients in 2018. Our counselors, attorneys and dentists also continued to provide their traditional quality care.

The Free Clinic of Simi Valley has for 47 years provided important primary services to those in need, despite any outside distractions. We are resolved to complete the capital campaign and create a new home for the Free Clinic and other community organizations, to come together to provide important services to those in need. We are "Paving a New Path for the Future."

2018 Highlights

In 2018, with the help of 141 volunteers, which included physicians, pharmacists, medical assistants, nurses, phlebotomists, dentists, hygienists, dental assistants, attorneys, MFT interns and MFT supervisors; the Free Clinic continued its proud record of helping the community; facilitating 10,573 client contacts and serving 2,818 clients. Our volunteer service value totaled \$702,948, which averaged roughly \$58,600 per month. Revenue (compared to 2017) increased by 144%, and expenses for the year increased 38%.

Make a Difference Award



In January the Center for Spiritual Living honored the Free Clinic with the Bea Thompson "Make a Difference Award." Executive Director, Fred Bauermeister graciously accepted the award at the special evening filled with giving and fun.

Our Anniversary



The Free Clinic reached a major milestone on March 1st - 47 Years. The photo above is the original location for the Clinic when it opened in 1971. The first year - 1200 patients were served: the number of those served over the last 47 years has surpassed 450,000.

Dental Program

Once again the Free Clinic participated in the Ventura County Dental Hygiene Association's Make a Difference Day. Forty one dental professionals and 24 college dental students volunteered and provided various dental services for roughly 50 children.

The Free Clinic is now the proud owner of an Oral C-T Scanner valued at \$85,000. This state-ofthe-art equipment was a

generous donation from Gendex. The scanner will allow dentists

to create 3-D images for more accurate extractions.

Passing of the Hammer



The tradition continues - the ceremonial "Passing of the Hammer." Attending physician Dr. Teresa Dieu Doan did the honors and passed the reflex hammer to the new attending physician Dr. Tafet for 2018-2019.

Depression is the leading cause of disability in the U.S. for ages 15 to 44; affecting more than 1.6 million American adults, or about 6.7% of the U.S. population age 18 or older in any given year. The Free Clinic's primary goal is to promote a healthy community and committed to focusing on the mental health issue because it is rapidly becoming more prevalent in our society.



Running enthusiasts from across Ventura and Los Angeles counties came out in full force to support this worthy cause, helping to make the event a huge success. The run was part of the Clinic's 8th annual Health Expo, in partnership with Adventist Health Simi Valley, which included an array of medical

screenings, vendors, fitness demonstrations, Rams Football cheerleaders, a cushy sofa for virtual runners and the popular Tooth Fairy 1K Kid's Fun Run.
