

2015 Report from Executive Director, Fred Bauermeister

2015 was a year of transition. Adriana Parsons, our beloved Medical Clinic Administrator, left the Clinic to pursue her dreams of becoming a nurse practitioner. Adriana had been with the Clinic for twelve years and was



loved, appreciated and respected by our patients, staff and volunteers. The Clinic's work is very personal. We meet people when they are not at their best. They are ill, depressed, having legal troubles, in pain from a bad tooth or some combination of the above. The Administrator is the primary contact and needs to be a person with great compassion, organizational skills and patience. We were fortunate that Adriana worked very closely

with Medical Assistant, Lupita Gonzalez, over the years.

Lupita was appointed to Clinic Administrator three months after Adriana's departure and has made the transition seamlessly. The Clinic's patients love Lupita, often bringing gifts of fresh fruit, flowers and baked goods. Lupita has an enormous heart and she advocates for our patients' care as if they were her family. We are excited that Lupita has taken on this key role at the Free Clinic.



Transitions continued as we endeavor to define the Clinic's role as the Affordable Care Act (ACA) becomes fully implemented. Our generous volunteers still see many folks that complain of high deductibles and narrow provider networks associated with the ACA, and many that are simply not enrolled.





Ron Hyrchuk was elected as President of the Board replacing Maggie Kestly who served the Board as President for the past five years. Maggie helped build the Board into a strong dynamic group of individuals. Ron brings his humor, insight and connections to Simi Valley Hospital to guide the Board through a variety of

complex issues, most importantly the completion of the *Under One Roof* project which will lead to a new home for our services.

Under One Roof will eventually house the Free Clinic's four programs and be a satellite office for 13 other non-profit organizations without office space here in Simi Valley. Completion of this project is vital to the future of the Free Clinic and will allow us to serve more people and offer additional services. It is our hope that we will be located in the **Under One Roof** facility in 2016.

When that day comes, it will be the biggest transition of all!

2015 Highlights

Through the efforts of over 160 volunteers, the Free Clinic had over 13,500 client contacts with 4,000+ people in 2015. The Clinic remains extremely efficient, delivering these increased services at a cost of \$27.05 per contact.

Other Highlights:

- On March 1st, the Free Clinic celebrated its 44th Anniversary of providing service to the community of Simi Valley.
- On March 8th, in partnership with the Ventura County Dental Hygienists Association, the Free Clinic's Dental program administered to the dental needs of over 80 children for "Make A Difference Day".



- In March, Kelly Ann Gaines, a community volunteer, joined the Free Clinic Board of Directors.
- The Clinic celebrated the graduation of the 2014/2015 Kaiser Permanente Family Resident Physicians: Roberta Obadadia, Anita Damodaran, Tracey Young, Mary Terrie Macaladad-Huerta, Kaori Nakasone and Francine Frater. Since 2007, over 47 physicians have received training at the Free Clinic through this program.
- Bernadette Gleason and Wendy Davis became licensed Marriage and Family Therapists. To date 51 Clinic interns have become licensed Marriage and Family Therapists.



 Lupita Gonzalez was promoted to from Medical Assistant to Clinic Administrator.

- In June, the Clinic celebrated the graduation of four Ambulatory Care Pharmacy residents: Troy Phipps, Petrina Maio, Paniz Joukur and Aimee Li. To date there have been 21 Ambulatory Pharmacists certified through the training program in partnership with Kaiser Permanente.
- In partnership with the Pepperdine Service Leadership Program under the direction of Dr. Regan Schaffer, consulting team students Kelly Corso, Kendall Rowden, Calvin Chiang and Mina Matsumoto presented a comprehensive Donor Communication Strategy.
- On October 17th, the Free Clinic, in partnership with Simi Valley Hospital, hosted its 5th Annual Tooth Fairy 5K /10K Run & Community Health Expo. The event was a smashing success with over 1,000 attendees, over 400 runners, and over 30 health and fitness vendors. The event provided net proceeds of over \$29,000 to fund the Clinic's programs.



- In December, Dr. Tracey Young joined the Free Clinic's Board of Directors.
- On December 4th, Representative Steve Knight,
 Congressman for the California 25th District, recognized the Free Clinic for its assistance to the community.



 For the holidays, Clinic volunteers wrapped and distributed over 150 Christmas presents to deserving children and teens who visited the Clinic.
